As regards M. D. (Microbiology), the Postgraduate Committee decided that the same may not be started for the present.

Regarding the clinical departments, the Postgraduate Committee directed the Secretary to find out if they have got atleast one whole-time non-practising unit in the concerned departments.

I am, therefore, to request you to please take necessary and immediate steps to rectify all the defects and deficiencies pointed out by the Council Inspectors in the report and also provide atleast one whole-time non-practising unit in the clinical departments and forward a detailed compliance report in due course to the Council for further consideration in the matter.
